1 SUN	Toronto / Athens Depart Toronto for Athens		
2 MON	Arrive Athens (Piraeus) Transfer to and embark ship Mykonos		11:00 AM 6:00 PM 11:00 PM
3 TUE	Kusadasi Meet and greet at harbour and discover the World Heritage Site of Ephesus . Photo stop at the remains of the Temple of Artemis , one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. After lunch, drive to one of the best popular markets in the region, the Market of Tire . Drive back to Selçuk . Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
4 WED	Selçuk / Sardis / Kucukkuyu (350 km) In the morning, depart for Sardis , the capital of the Kingdom of Lydia . Visit the Bath - Gymnasium Complex , the 3 rd century AD marble paved Synagogue and the Temple of Artemis located in the Pactolus Valley. Then proceed to Pergamum , the capital of the Attalid dynasty. After lunch, visit this ancient city where parchment was invented. Highlights include the Acropolis , the library , the podium on which stood the Zeus Altar and the impressive theatre built into the steep hillside with a wonderful panorama of the surroundings. Visit the Asclepion , a sanctuary and healing centre dedicated to the god of healing, Asclepius. Continue to Kucukkuyu . Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
5 THU	Kucukkuyu / Assos / Troy / Çanakkale (180 km) In the morning, depart for Assos to visit the Athena Temple . Then drive to the ancient city of Troy whose history covers a period of about 3,400 years. King Priam's glorious city was immortalized in Homer's epic, The Iliad, which brought to life the stories of Helen, Menelas, Paris, Agamemnon, Achilles and Hector. Continue to Çanakkale . Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
6 FRI	Çanakkale / Istanbul (340 km) In the morning, cross the Strait of the

	Dardanelles by ferry to Gallipoli where the dramatic battles of WWI took place. Brief visit of the battlefields. Continue to Istanbul . Lunch on the way. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
7 SAT	Istanbul After breakfast, visit the Soliman Mosque which exemplifies the best of Ottoman architecture, Rustempasa Mosque with its beautiful Iznik (Nicea) tiles, and the Spice Market with its exotic spices and aromas. After lunch, free time at the Istiklal Street. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
8 SUN	Istanbul In the morning visit the Blue Mosque . The interior is decorated with 21,043 predominantly blue tiles from Iznik. You will see the Hippodrome, as well as the imposing Haghia Sophia which marked the apogee of Byzantine Emperor Justinian's reign. Lunch. In the afternoon, visit Topkapi Palace , the residence of the Ottoman sultans from the late 15 th century to the first half of the 19 th . Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, L, D)		
9 MON	Istanbul / Izmir / Sileçuk (approx. 60 km) After breakfast, visit the historical Grand Bazaar. Lunch, then board your flight to Izmir . Transfer to Sileçuk. Check-in and dinner at the hotel.		
10 TUE	Izmir / Kusadasi (approx. 80 km) Transfer to and embark ship Patmos	4:00 PM	9:00 PM NOON
11 WED	Rhodes	7:00 AM	6:00 PM
12 THU	Crete (Heraklion) Santorini	7:00 AM 4:30 PM	11:30 AM 9:00 PM
